

Widow's Declaration for Pension or Increase of Pension.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 27 day of March A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty three

personally appeared before me a justice of the Peace a Court of Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Maria Jones

aged 62 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain

the Pension provided by Acts of Congress granting pension to widows: That she is the widow of Valentine Jones

, who enlisted under the name of Valentine Jones

at Co. F, on the 29 day of March A. D. 1862

in The 39th Md. Vol. Inf. (Company and Regiment of service, if in the army; or vessel and rank, if in the navy.)

in the war of The Rebellion who died of disability

due to the service (State nature of wounds and all circumstances attending them)

or the disease and manner in which it was incurred, in either case showing soldier's death to have been the sequence.)

on the 23 day of March A. D. 1891

who bore at the time of his death the rank of Private in the service aforesaid, or otherwise.)

that she was married under the name of Maria Powell to said

Valentine Jones, on the 16 day of July A. D. 1862 by

J. H. Henshaw at Baltimore there being no legal

barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married (If either have been previously married)

so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.)

that she has to present date remained his widow; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate children yet surviving who were under sixteen years of age at father's death, viz:

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance.

(For such children as are not under her care claimant should account.)

that she has not in any manner engaged in, or aided or abetted the rebellion in the United States; that prior application has been filed (If prior application has been filed, either by soldier or widow, so state, giving number assigned to it.)

that she hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

her attorney to prosecute the above claim; that her residence is No. 7133 Water street
