

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

To be executed before a Notary Public, Justice of the Peace, or any officer competent to administer oaths.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, ss.

On this 13th day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

personally appeared before me, Henry Duval, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid,

Benjamin Welch, aged 49 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore County of Baltimore, State of Maryland,

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Benjamin Welch, who was ENROLLED on the Eighteenth day of May, 1864, in Co D 19th Regt Md Inf

Private in Co D 19th Regt Md Inf (Here state rank, company and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy)

in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Brownsville Texas, on the 15th day of January, 1867 That he

is unable to earn a support by reason of Gunshot Wound of the right thigh between the hip & knee, disease in the throat - Eyes, and also, (Lindis & Weakness

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has none

applied for pension under application No. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No. 248261

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States, under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Walter Middleton, of Washington, State of D.C.

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS as prescribed by law. That his POST-OFFICE ADDRESS is 128 Ridgely St. Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland
