I have the honor to return herewith your request for a report of hospital treatment in Claim No. 335-801, with such information as is furnished by the records filed in this Office, viz: that Pvt. Edward Parker, Co. F 39 U.S. C. D. entered F. H. H. A. C. Raleigh N. C. April 16/65. Diagnosis "Weakness" disposition not stated. He entered Post Hospital Raleigh N. C. May 21-1865. with Diarrhoea, and was returned to duty June 5/65. No further record of soldier's treatment found. There are no records of the Regiment on file. List of Casualties for the Regiment at Sugar Loaf Mt. N. C. Feb. 11/65 furnishes no information in this case.
