

# DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

This Must be Executed Before a Court of Record or Some Officer Thereof Having Custody of its Seal.

ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, on the

day of Dec, 1865. That he is unable to earn a support by

reason of g. s. w. of neck rec'd at Southville N.C. + of left eye + for which he has already claimed under old law, also rheumatism, rupture of right side + disease of eyes

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That

he has applied for pension under application No. but don't know the That he is a pensioner
