DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

On this 5 day of Dec. A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one personally appeared before me, J. P.

within and for the county and State aforesaid Amanda Parker, aged 35 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore, county of

State of Maryland who, being duly sworn according

to law, declares that she is the widow of Edward Parker,

who enlisted under the name of Edward Parker

at Balto. Md., on the day of

A. D. 18, in Co. F 39 2 S. C. Inf. (Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in Military service, or vessel, if in Navy.)

and served at least ninety days in the war of the rebellion; who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED, and died M. (The cause of death need not be stated.)

That she was married under the name of Amanda Piddrij, to said Edward Parker, on the 25 day of Oct. November 1882, by Rev. St. M. Green, at Balto. Md.

there being no legal barrier to said marriage. no prior marriage of either party (If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.)

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Edward Parker (Name of soldier or sailor.)

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor. That names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:
