BASIS OF CLAIM.

Alleges in declaration filed July 12, 1880 at Myran Loop Battery, N.C., July 11, 1865 while storming the Battery he was struck by a Minié ball on right side of his neck. Wound jagular vein, breaking off a piece of the lower jaw and knocking out several teeth, causing a permanent impediment in his speech. Also wound of right arm & ear & left eye, cutting a portion of left ear.
