 may be done the Claimant I
 shall recommend further ex-
 amination.

Dependence at ecclishment, and
 from Discharge to 1867. Claim-
 ant, and her husband was moving
 about so much from 1866 to the
 time they moved to Shepherso-
 town that testimony of dependence
 cannot be shown away from
 Baltimore. Claimant's husband
 being a Methodist Circuit Preacher,
 with no steady charge. Jarrett
 Bowman died June 11 1878. The
 Claimant contradicts the situation
 when she says that her son gave
 her no money, and did not con-
 tribute to her support, during
 the last three years of his life,
 on the contrary she had to help
 care for him, and at his death
 had to pay his funeral expenses.
