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all of Baltimore Md.

Daniel C Bowdley who was in the same regiment with my son, and his Mother Mrs Bowdley both of Baltimore Md, & living can testify. I cannot recall the names of any others now living who knew us in Baltimore Md unless it be William Hittington, a drayman, who lived on the same street we did, and Aleck Hawkins, address unknown and I cannot recall what his occupation was.

Q What was the largest amount your son George ever sent, or gave you, after you left Baltimore?

A He never sent or gave me more than three dollars at any one time. He was sick a long time and could not work and had little to support himself with. He did not send me any money for several years prior to his death. I had to send him money to help him along.

He got behind in his Society and G A R Pasts and when he died they would not bury him on that account, so I had to furnish the money to bury him with as I have stated. I have no means of support now, and all the property I own, is this little house, and the lot it stands on. I am supported by my daughter who takes in washing. When I was physically able I went out as a nurse but I
