

I have been able to find Mrs Bowdly or her son Daniel C. Bowdly - none of these names appear in the directory. I interviewed Wm Whittington, but he claimed to have no knowledge whatever of any of the parties in the case.

So far as I can learn the soldier first lived with a woman named Clara Elias, and had one child by her, a son, whose name is Harry Elias. His address is Watkins Hotel, Baltic Ave., near N. Carolina ave., Atlantic City, N. J. He is said to be about 20 years old now, and his mother still lives, either with him or somewhere in Philadelphia.

It is stated that he never was married to this woman.

Subsequently he was married to Olivia Hawkins, by whom he had about ten children, all dying in infancy. The wife, Olivia, died March 15, 1882, see E & A.

He next married Martha L. Parker. (see E & B.) by whom he had one child which out lived the soldier, but died before the mother died.
