

PROOF OF DISABILITY.

STATE OF Maryland COUNTY OF Baltimore, SS.

On this 16 day of March; 1893, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace in and for the County and State aforesaid, duly authorized to administer oaths Isiah Cornish, aged 52 years and a resident of Baltimore City, County of Baltimore and State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, states that he is acquainted with Geo. H. Harris, whose mother is, applicant for ~~Invalid~~ Pension, and knows the said George H. Harris to be the identical person of that name who served as a Corporal in Company C H, Regiment of A. I. C. I.

and who ~~was discharged~~ at Fortoa Monroe, on or about the 29 day of May, 1865, by reason of close of war.

That the said George H. Harris while in line of his duty, at or near the Sharpsburg, in the State of MD, did, on or about the 29 day of December, 1864, become disabled in the following manner, viz:

From exposure incident to the service. He contracted disease of lungs, and suffered from said disease during the remainder of his period of service.
