

DECLARATION FOR AN ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss :

On this 9th day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eightynine personally appeared before me, Copy Clerk of the Superior Court, a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, George H. Smith, aged

46 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore county of Md., who, being duly sworn according to law, declares

that he is the identical George H. Smith who was Enrolled on the day of March, 1864, in Company H. of the 39th Regiment of U.S.A. commanded by Capt Babcock

and who was honorably Discharged at Alexandria Va. on the 27 day of May, 1865 that his personal description is as follows: Age, 46 years; height 5 feet 5 inches; complexion, dark; hair, dark; eyes, dark

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Heldon R.R. near Petersburg, in the State of Va. on or about the 30 day of July, 1864 he

While in action was Wounded in left shoulder & has suffered from said wound ever since, being now unable to perform manual labor 1/2 the time on account of same.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: City Point & Alexandria Va.

Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and, as near as possible, the dates of arrival and departure from each.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the day of 1864

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Md., and that his occupation has been that of a carpenter

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when en-

rolled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has never received nor applied for a pension;
