# Declaration for Pension.

Under the Act of February 6, 1907.

On this 28th day of December A. D. one thousand nine hundred and ten, personally appeared before me

John H. Murphy a resident of the City

United States in the Civil War, and served at least 90 days, and was HONOR-  
(Civil or Mexican) (90 days if Civil War; 60 days if Mexican)

ABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, Md., on the 23 day of Dec 1865

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated  
above.

That he is 70 years of age, having been born on the 20th day of December 1840  
and asks for a pension of \$\_\_\_\_\_ per month [62 years of age, \$12; 70 years, \$15; 75 years or over, \$20]

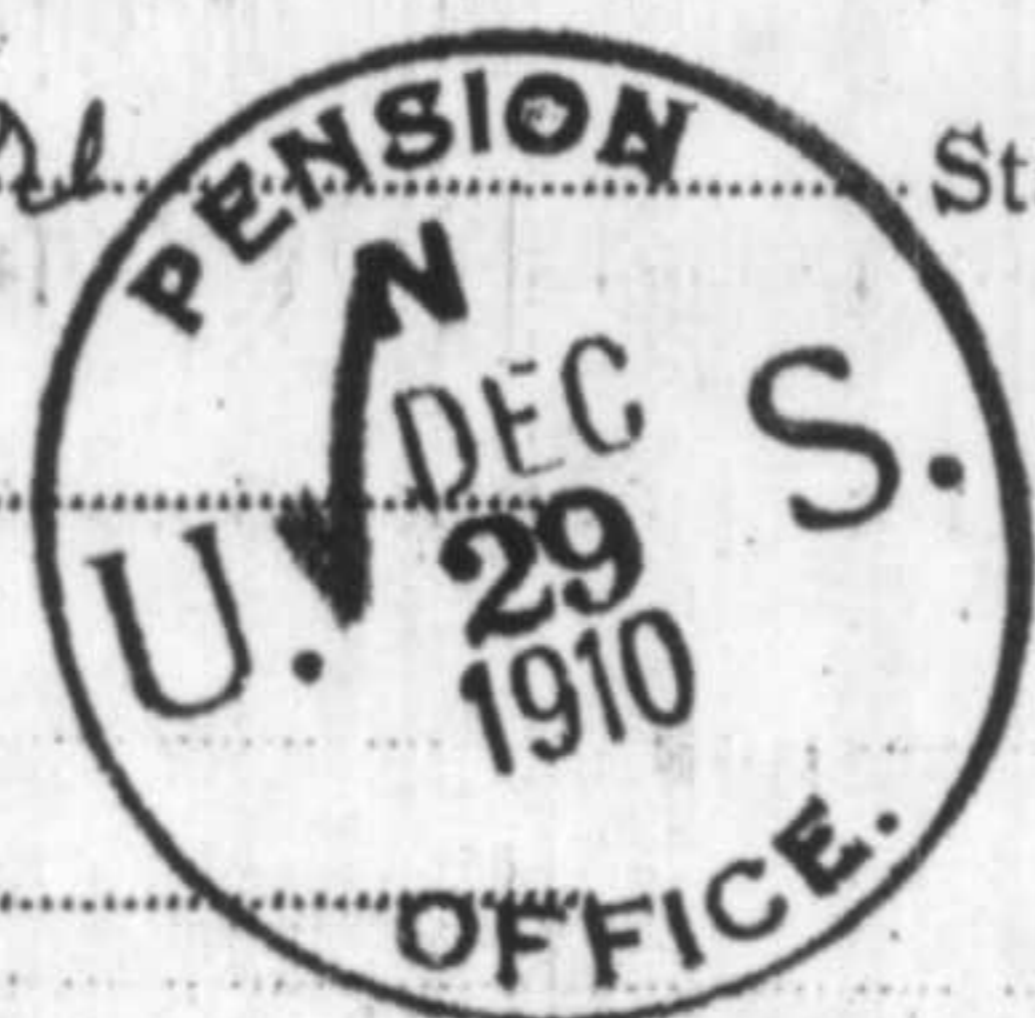
