Re-consideration and re-examination of claimant asked.

To the Honorable Commissioner of Pensions:

I respectfully ask that my claim for Pensions, above referred to, which has been rejected on the ground that I have "no ratable disability" be re-opened for the following reasons:

1st. I have disabilities OTHER than those ORIGINALLY claimed for in my application.

2nd. The ground of rejection is erroneous. I really am permanently disabled. The disability is not such as shows itself with equal severity every day, and I may have been in particularly good physical condition when medically examined.

3. I furnish positive proof of disability; and I respectfully call attention to the evidence herewith and hitherto filed being:

- (a) My sworn allegations as to NEW disabilities,
- (b) Affidavit of reputable Physician showing existence of an actual and permanent disability, and
- (c) Testimony of credible persons to same effect.

I therefore respectfully ask a re-consideration of my rejected claim, my re-examination, if necessary, before another Board, and I appoint A. Parlett Lloyd, my true and lawful Attorney.
