Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims to suffer with rheumatism at times in the knees and legs and at other times in the wrists and arms. Contracted bronchitis in the army and has suffered at intervals ever since. Voice gives way at times. Hearing is bad in both ears, especially the left.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 4 inches; weight, 128 pounds; age, 51 years. General physical condition fair.

No crepitation or deformity of the joints, pain on manipulation, apparent limitation of motion, or other evidence of rheumatism. States that he is not suffering at the present time. Heart is normal.

Chest well developed. Expansion is good. No evidence of bronchitis. Auscultation and percussion show the lungs to be in healthy condition.

No evidence of affection of the throat. States that he has no cough at the present time.

Ears: External auditory canals clear. Membranes normal in appearance. Hearing is good. Has no difficulty whatever in understanding ordinary conversation with both ears at distance of over six feet.

Abdominal organs are in healthy condition.

Claimant may suffer at times with the disabilities above claimed, but there is no evidence at present, nor does he claim that he is suffering at this time.

No other disability exists.
