When I moved to *Temple St.*, this  
 city, some two or three years before  
 the war claimed and *Berij Davis*  
 then lived there as man and wife,  
 recognized each other as such and  
 were so regarded in the neighbor-  
 hood; we were neighbors there for  
 five or six years; soldier enlisted while  
 he lived there; I don't know what  
 company and reg't he was in; after  
 they moved from *Temple St.*, I lost track  
 of them until about three years  
 ago, when I moved into their neigh-  
 borhood; I heard of her husband's  
 death at the time he died; I can't  
 say when that was; I know that  
 for the past three years she has  
 been recognized in the community  
 as the widow of soldier; she owns the  
 house she lives in; I can't say how  
 much it is worth but it would  
 rent for probably \$10 per month;  
 she is dependent upon her own  
 labor for support.
