Sir: I have the honor to return herewith the papers received from your office in pension claim No. 491506, with such information as is furnished by records filed in this Office, viz: that Jesse Frey, Pvt. Co. G, 4<sup>th</sup> U.S. Inf., was admitted to Hampton G. H. Fort Monro Va. May 1, 64 with Sprain of Wrist, & transferred Aug. 15, 64, & that Jesse Frey, Pvt. Co. I, 4<sup>th</sup> U.S. Inf. was admitted to Summit House G. H. Kingessing Phila. Pa. Aug. 17, 64 from Hampton, with Debility & Epilepsy diagnosis also shown as Dislocation of left wrist, and as Rheumatism (Under date of Nov. 4. Case book shows "has some Catarrh" and Nov. 18. that "patient has not a dislocation of left wrist, but the ligaments and Capsular membrane of scaphoid & scaphoid bones connected with the radius & ulna are so injured by extension as to make it impossible to bend or move the hand") was furloughed Dec 22, 64, re-admitted Jan 7, 65 & discharged from service May 5, 65. on Surg. Certf. of disability
