

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

to be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in the State, city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or a clerk of a court shall be necessary; but when no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall affix his official seal thereto, and shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, SS:

On this 4th day of September, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety four personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace of the City within and for the county and State aforesaid, Natie Fry aged 32 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore county of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of Jesse Fry, who enlisted under the name of Jesse Fry at Baltimore on the 11th day of August, A. D. 1863, in C. I. 4th U. S. Cal. Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in military service, Vol. Infantry as private or vessel, if in the Navy.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was honorably discharged May 5th 1865, and died 24th day of August 1894 The cause of death need not be stated.

That she was married under the name of Natie Bowyer to said Jesse Fry on the 16th day of June, 1876 by Rev Jas H. Handy, at Baltimore Md, there being no legal barrier to said marriage. Neither had ever previously married If there was a former marriage of claimant or her husband, state it here and how dissolved.

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Jesse Fry Name of soldier or sailor.

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor; that names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:

That her husband has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Mr. E. W. Ross of Baltimore State of Maryland, her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, and to receive therefor a fee of ten dollars; that her post-office address is 1145 N.
