WE HEREBY CERTIFY that in compliance with the requirements of the law* we have carefully examined this applicant, who claims that while in the service of the United States at or near a place named Williamsburg Va., and while in line of duty, on or about the

day of ... 1864, he incurred injury to wrist & epilepsy.

and that in consequence thereof he is 3/4 disabled for earning his subsistence by manual labor
His pulse-rate is 90 per minute; his respiration 17; his temperature 98 1/2; his height is 5 feet and 2 1/2 inches; he weighs 150 pounds, and states that he is 43 years of age.

Touching the cause and degree of the disability for which he claims a pension, he makes the following statement: Says at time of wounds above named that he incurred above named injury & disease which suffered ever since from same.

General appearance healthy. The voice & its original vicium sound. No scars or other evidence of injury to left wrist. Both wrists are of same size & shape, with all movements present; but applicant complains of much pain on pressure on left wrist and also in all movements, especially in extreme extension. He therefore rate low for same. Index mid. & ring fingers of right hand amputated through

The examination reveals the following objective facts in support of his statements: ... phalanges, (since the war) & hence not pensionable. Hearing, Sight, tactile sensation & patella-reflex normal. Man does not stand, nor walk steadily with eyes closed, but these are the only symptoms of cerebral nerve lesion. His speech is distinct & intellect clear & as he does not have a fit in our presence we cannot say whether he has epilepsy or not. This man is suffering from an extensive vitiligo, which he says was gotten in the service.

From the existing condition and the history of this claimant, as stated by himself, it is, in our judgment, probable that the disability was incurred in the service as he claims, and that it has not been aggravated or prolonged by vicious habits. He is, in our opinion, entitled to a rating for the disability caused by injury to left wrist & 0 for that caused by epilepsy, and for that caused by the sum of which aggregates 2/5
