Sir:

I have the honor to return, herewith, claim No. 431,809, of Route Hills, post office address No. 609, Price St. Baltimore City, Md. widow of William Hills, late private Co. B, 19th U. S. Col. Inf. Regt.

Soldier was a pensioner under Act No. 186,109, for gunshot wound of right wrist, and he died June 27, 1890, from abscess of head, not due to his service.

Widow's claim filed July 1, 1890, under Act of June 27, 1890.

The report of the Board of Health of Baltimore City, shows soldier a widower, at time of death. Special Examiner ordered to determine whether claimant is the legal widow of soldier.

I reviewed the record in this case with an error and due solely to the carelessness of the physician, Dr. B. B. Brown, who made the report. I called on Dr. Brown for an explanation, which he refused to give, saying that the widow owed him fifteen dollars for medicine.
