of his service

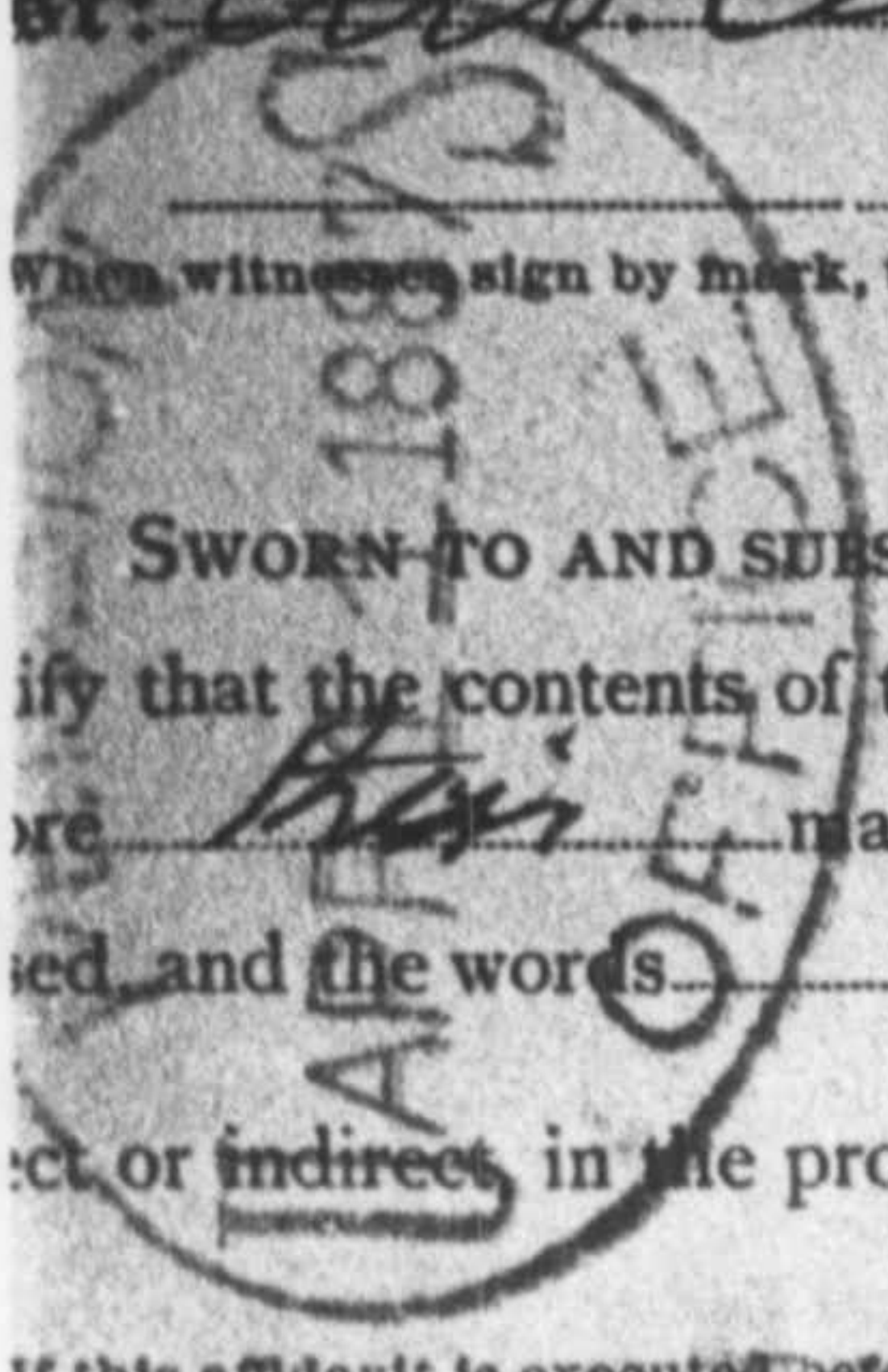
