Sir:-

In response to your call of the 2nd, received the 4th instant (BHW.326-338,334), relative to the case of John Moales, of #445 Druid Hill Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, late of Co. B, 39" U.S.C. Infantry, Cert. #748,103, you are advised as follows:

Louisa Murdock and A. P. Lloyd, of Baltimore, Maryland, testified, May 11, 1907, that they have known John Moales for 8 and 4 years, respectively, and believe him to be the identical person he represents himself to be.

Similar testimony is given by Alfred Castor and Charles S. Stewart, of Baltimore, Maryland, in their affidavit of October 10, 1906, wherein they testify to an acquaintance with John Moales^B of 42 and 50 years, respectively.

James H. Samuel and C. T. Stewart, of Baltimore, Maryland, testified, May 8, 1905, that they have known John Moales for 10 and 50 years, respectively, and believe him to be the identical person he holds himself out to be.
