financial affairs, having visited the family frequently.

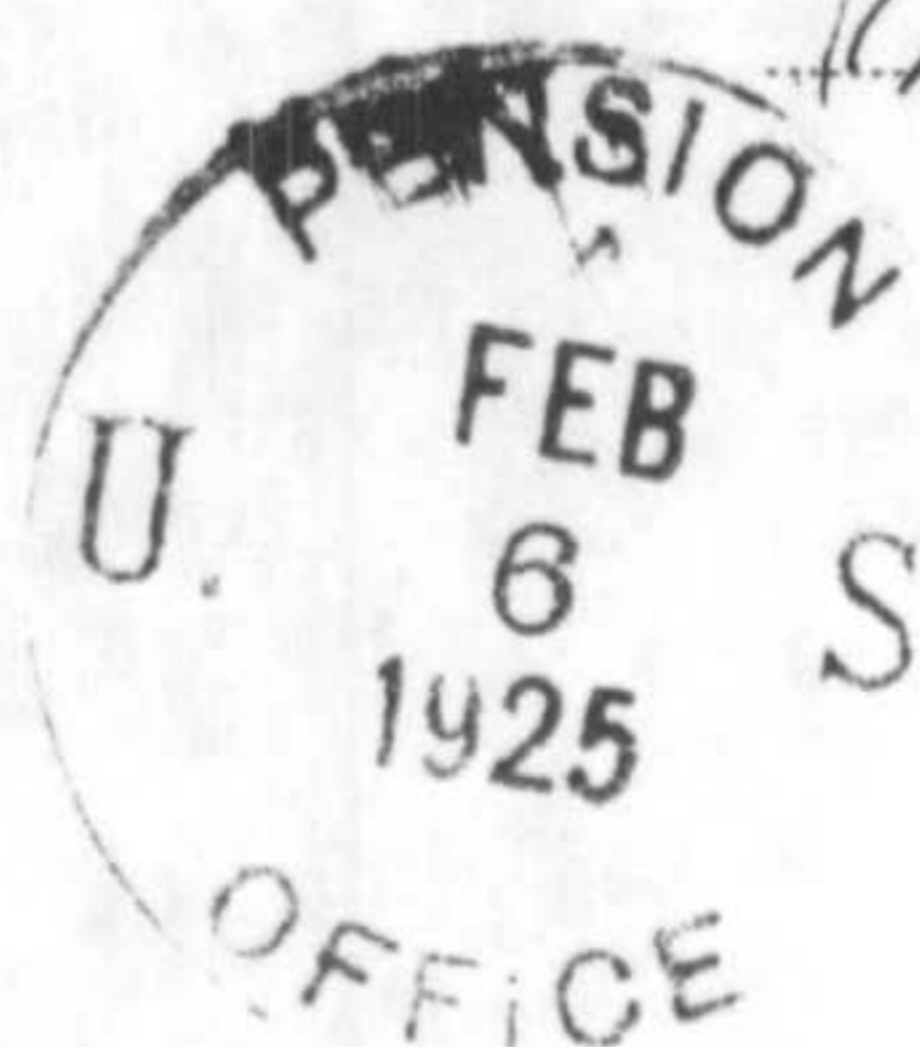
