

whose ages are established by the  
evidence of the attending physician -  
and beside the bible record was not  
made until sometime after the  
children were born - and the ones  
then written by some one who de-  
pended upon claimant's statement  
as to correct dates.

In as much as the accuracy of  
claimant's memory and state-  
ment is established, and cor-  
roborated by the records and  
evidence of the attending phy-  
sicians in the cases of the young-  
est children - I believe the date  
of the birth of the oldest children  
can also be accepted as correctly  
given by the claimant.

There were no physicians present at  
the dates of birth of the two boys claimed  
for - and the mid-wife in attendance  
whose name was born is ignorant -  
without education and has a very  
poor memory - and can give no  
date.

5 After having seen this midwife I  
returned to claimant and told  
her it would be necessary to furnish
