In as much as Katie Howard lives about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from claimant, had not been coached by her, and the witness's reputation and intelligence are good I believe her evidence should be accepted as sufficient to establish correct dates of birth of the two boys; at any rate nothing better can be had.
