

DECLARATION FOR ARREARS OF PENSION.

On this 10th day of November, A.D. one thousand eight hundred and Sixty eight personally appeared before me, a ~~Justice of the Peace~~ within and for the County and State aforesaid, Thomas Woolford, aged 24 years, a resident of Cambridge in the State of Md., who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical person to whom was granted Pension Certificate No. 50,830, payable at the agency at Baltimore, and dated Oct. 17 1866; that under the limitations of the Act of _____ was denied a Pension from the date of his discharge

and believing himself entitled to the same, under the 6 section of the Act of July 27, 1868, he makes this declaration in order to secure the arrears accrued thereunder. He also declares that he has never been in the civil service of the United States & was not employed by the Government between March 3 1865 & June 6 1866.
