personally appeared before me a Clerk of the Circuit Court a Court

aged 46 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following Declaration in order to obtain the
Pension provided by Acts of Congress granting pension to widows: That she is the widow of Joseph Moxley

, who enlisted under the name of Joseph Moxley
at Hagerstown, Md. on the 8th day of September A. D. 1863

in Batt of First Brigade of U. S. Cal Troops
(Company and Regiment of service, if in the army; or vessel and rank if in the navy.)

in the war of Rebellion who died at Hagerstown Md
Sept 1st 1865 from the results of Scumy contracted
and manner in which it was incurred, in either case showing soldier's death to have been the sequence.

while in Service at Brownsville Texas in 1865.

She is informed that he was not in hospital but was treated
at Brigades Head Quarters by Surgeon Potts. A. D.

who bore at the time of his death the rank of 1st ("In the service aforesaid" or otherwise.)

that she was married under the name of Mary Quinn to said Joseph Moxley

on the 29th day of September A. D. 1859 by
Rev. Danage L. Hammon at Hagerstown Md there being no legal

barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married
(If either have been previously married

so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.)

that she has to present date remained his widow; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate
