

I worked along with him at farm labor from the late William Logan - then post master of Hagerstown - within a year or so after his return from the army and he was complaining more or less of his left side all the time at that period and his legs were sore.

And he always continued to complain of his side and his mouth was nearly always sore afterward as long as he lived but he was always able to be about and to do some work on up to the time of his death but I do not know the date or cause of his death.

I have heard this statement read and understood it and am not related to Clement or the soldier nor interested in this claim for pension.
