Madam:-

You are advised that your claim for reimbursement in the case of Sarah A. Moxley, certificate number 516,257, is disallowed on the ground that pensioner left assets, consisting of real estate, the assessed value of which is shown to be \$1500.00, less a mortgage for \$800.00, also \$16.00, the proceeds of an industrial insurance policy, total \$716.00, sufficient to meet the expenses of her last sickness and burial, alleged to have \$709.00, and under such circumstances, the payment of the accrued pension for the purpose of reimbursement, is prohibited by the act of March 2, 1895.
