 known to me who is reputable and entitled
 to credit, who being duly sworn, declares
 in relation to aforesaid case as follows:
 That after her marriage to soldier
 in April 1861 she lived with her
 mother in Bonsabon, Washington County,
Maryland for about two months,
 her husband working at the time
 at the Washington House, at Hagerstown,
Maryland. We then lived in Hagerstown,
 Washington County, Maryland for about
 a year, when we moved to the Grove
 farm near Hagerstown, Maryland, where
 my husband was employed. My
