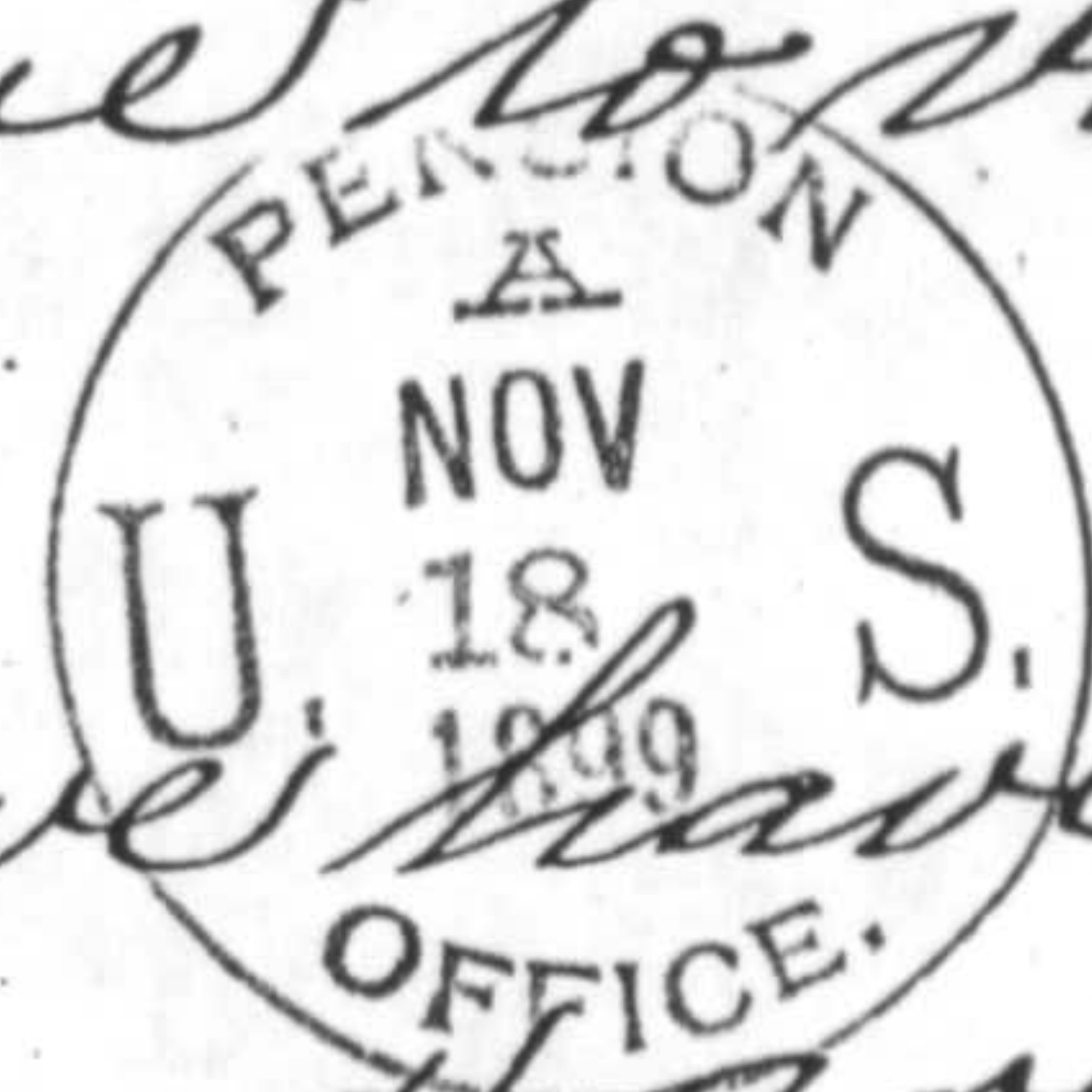
We hereby certify that
