accident occurred to him. It is right
ankle was broken during the month
of October 1883 and it occurred on Wal-
ter Street, Stagerstown Maryland.
Moxley was driving a hack along the
side of the Cumberland Valley Rail-
road at the time on the above named
street when his horses became frightened
at the approach of a train. The horses
jumped aside and the hack was
turned suddenly around. Moxley
was thrown violently to the ground
striking the railroad rail with his
right ankle — the latter being broken
by the fall
