Declaration for the Re-Rating of an Invalid Pension,

 ON THE DATE HEREINAFTER MENTIONED, personally appeared before me, a *Notary Public*
 within and for the County and State aforesaid *Perry Mosley*
 aged *67* years, a resident of *Agrestown* County of *Washington* State
 of *Md.* who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the
 United States, under *Act of June 27, 1890* enrolled at the *Agrestown* Pension Agency at
 the rate of *5* Dollars per month, Certificate No. *472 99* by reason of
Partial inability to earn a support by manual labor
 That he served as a *Musical in 1st. Brigade Band U.S. Col. Troop*
 State Rank, company and regiment, if in the army; or, the name of the vessel, if in the navy.
 That he believes himself to be entitled to a re-rating of his pension for the following reasons, to
 wit: **Rating has been disproportionate to the degree of disability.**

He also requests that his right to a rating from the date of filing of his first application for pension under the Act of June 27, 1890, be considered in accordance with the provisions of the Act of March 6, 1896.

 neys, to present and prosecute his claim, requesting that, in the event of an allowance being
 made, his said attorneys be paid a fee, as provided by law for the successful prosecution of a pen-
