

Declaration for Invalid Pension.

[Act of June 27, 1890.]

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the County and State aforesaid James G. Gould aged 57 years, a resident of the County of Baltimore State of Maryland who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

In addition to above he had military or naval service in any army or navy (If no other service insert "No" and "either" in proper places.) prior or subsequent thereto.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has 279216 applied for pension under application No. 279216 That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 279216 [If a pensioner, the certificate number only]

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints James G. Gould his true and lawful attorneys, to prosecute his claim, and for and in consideration of services done and to be done in the premises, he hereby agrees to pay said attorneys a fee of ten dollars which shall include all amounts to be paid for any services in the furtherance of said claim under the act of June 27, 1890, and said fee shall not be deemed by or payable to said attorney in whole or in part, except in case of the granting of a pension by the Commissioner of Pensions under the act of June 27, 1890, and that the same shall be paid them in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of said Act and other laws pertaining thereto.
