DECLARATION FOR AN ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

and ninety-one, personally appeared before me a Notary Publicof the COURT OF RECORD within and for the county and State aforesaid Edward Turner aged 47 years, who, beingduly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Edward Turner, who was ENROLLED as a Private on the 17day of September 1863 in Company F of the 7 Regiment ofU. S. C. T., commanded by Capt. Oscar O. Pratt, and was honorably DISCHARGED at Fort Baltimore on the 6day of September, 1866; that his personal description is as follows: age 47 years; height 5 feet 3 inches; complexion black; hair black; eyes dk. brown.That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty, at Fort Gilmore in the State of Virginia, on or about the 7 day of August, 1864, he was

wounded in the right thigh by a gun shot, and also, at Camp Jacksonville, Florida, he was run struck, in June 1864, from the effects of which run stroke he still suffers, more or less at all times, particularly in summer,That he was treated in hospitals, as follows: at Camp Hampton, & from there to Davis Island, Md., for g. c. r., & in Regimental Hospital for Run-Stroke.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 6 day of September 1866.That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, and that his occupation has been that of a laborer.That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound physical health, being when enrolled a house servant.That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation Langshaw Island of Washington, D.C.his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has not received nor applied for a pension; that his residence is No. 706 Saratoga street Baltimore, Maryland, and that his post-office address is the same.
