We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law* we have carefully examined

this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz:

Cause of disability.

If a pensioner, fill in the amount; if not, erase the whole line.

Rheumatism and resulting disease of heart and alleged resulting disease of left lung
and that he receives a pension of Four (4) dollars per month.

Pulse rate per minute, 100; respiration, 20; temperature, 99; height, 5 feet 6 inches; weight, 174 pounds; age, 44 years.

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for increase
Claims to suffer from rheumatism worse at present time in right arm left leg and in neck. Suffer with pain and palpitation of heart with shortness of breath. Cough at night. All symptoms worse in damp weather.

Here give a full symptom picture of the case, embracing all the physical and rational signs, but confining it to the present condition of the claimant.

It must be borne in mind that the duty of the Surgeon is to give an opinion as to the proportionate degree of disability, as to total, &c., through the grades, without any regard to dollars and cents, and to make such a full particular description as will afford to this Office the ground for intelligent opinion and action in rating.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions
General physical condition is good.
Crepitation in both lungs with pain on motion. Has some difficulty in walking especially in left leg.
Pain in right shoulder and surrounding muscles extending upward along side of neck. Pain when moving the arm.
Heart action is very rapid. Apex displaced slightly to left. No valvular lesion.
Chest well developed. Measurement 39 1/2.
Inspiration 40. Expiration 38 1/2 inches.
There is some harshness of respiratory sounds over right lung but otherwise the lungs are normal.
From his description his attacks are probably asthmatic in character.
No other disability.

From the existing condition and the history of this claimant, as stated by himself, it is, in our judgment, probable that the disability was incurred in the service as he claims, and that it has not been prolonged or aggravated by vicious habits. He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 9/8

Rate for each cause of disability. If prolonged by vicious habits, the word not should be erased and the reason for the erasure given.
