marriage was October 22, 1866, and that after the

death of the Rev. Richard Lane all of his church

records were delivered to his successor and many

were lost, among them the record of the aforesaid

marriage, but that she was present and witnessed

the marriage.

Also on the 14th August, 1916 appeared Samuel Adams, at

age 74 and made oath in due form of law that he was well acquainted

with Samuel Price and Martha Price, and that he

was present at the marriage ceremony; his present
