

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION

State of Maryland, County of Prince George's, ss:

On this 11th day of January A. D. 1917, personally appeared before me, a Notary public within and for the county and State aforesaid, William Johnson,

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 71 years of age, and a resident of Camden, county of Camden, State of New Jersey;

and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Chestertown Kent County State of Maryland under the name of William Johnson, on the 7th day of May, 1863, as a private in Co. E, 7th Md. Col. Vols.

(Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the rebellion war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Fort Monroe V.A., on the 7th day of September, 1865

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet, 3 inches; complexion, dark; color of eyes, dark; color of hair, dark; that his occupation was farming; that he was born March 2d 1845, at Easton Md., Queens Ann Co. Md.

disability, Cause by being wounded in the left foot also in the left breast, caused by gunshot in battle. (If it is desired to claim under the disability clause, the nature of the disability and the date, place, and circumstances under which it was incurred in line of duty should be alleged in this space. A disability which did not originate in the service and in line of duty can not be considered.)

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: after being discharged from the army in Sept. 1865, resided State of Md 5 years, State of Del., 4, State of New Jersey 4 3 years

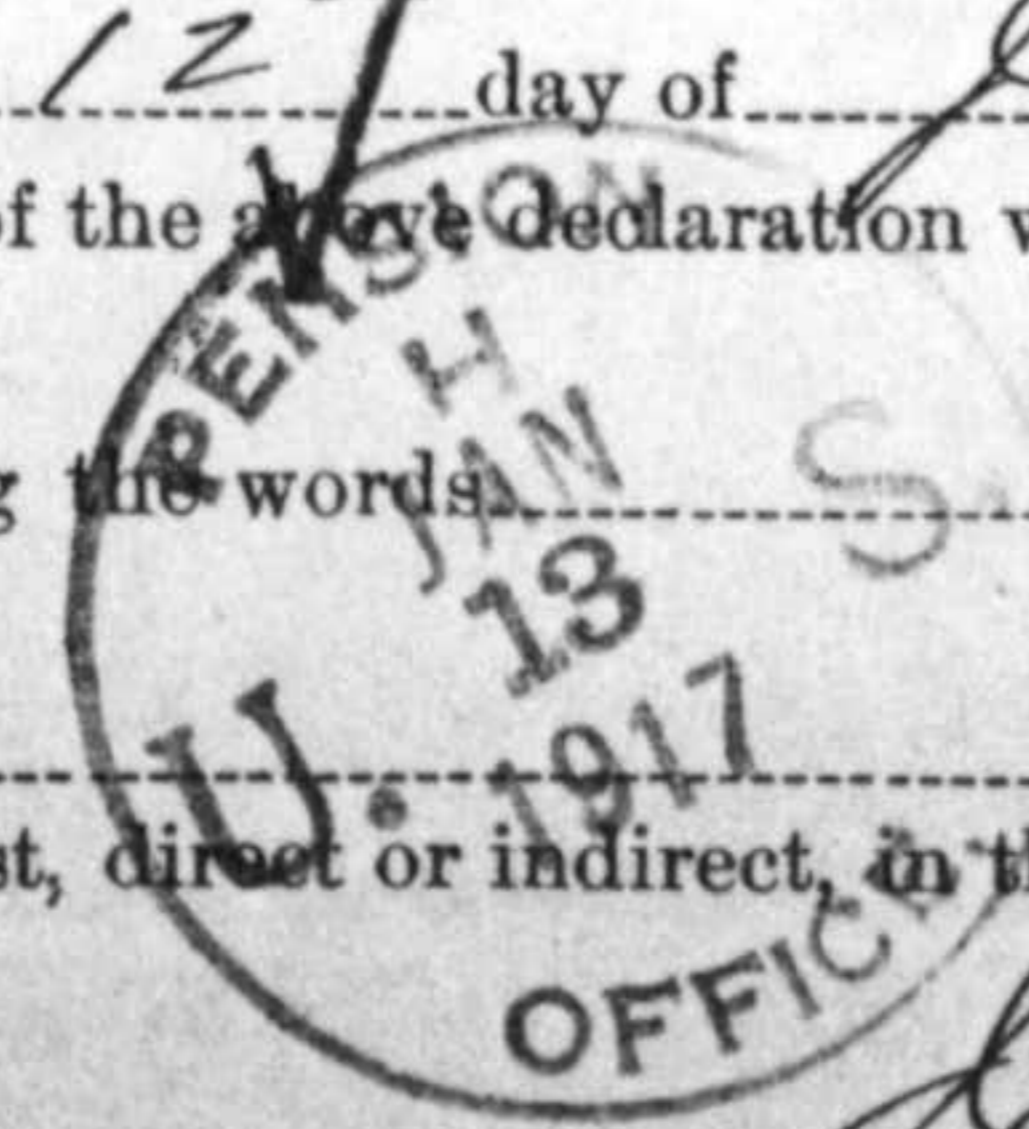
That he is a pensioner under certificate No. That he has applied for pension under original No.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of May 11, 1912. That his post-office address is Laurel, county of Prince George's, State of Maryland
