

Act of June 27, 1890.

Declaration for Invalid Pension.

State of Maryland County of Anne Arundel ss:ON THIS October day of October A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety fourbefore me, a Justice of the Peace in and for the Countyand State aforesaid, personally appeared Edward Taskeraged 57 years, a resident of Annapolis, county of Anne ArundelState of Maryland, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is theidentical George H. Tasker who was enrolled on the 11thday of March, 1864, as private in Co. 26, 30th Reg't U. S. 6th I. Vols.,
Here state rank, company and regiment, if in the Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.

in the service of the United States during the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was

honorably discharged at or near Philadelphia Baltimorein the State of Maryland, on the 14 day of April, 1864That he is partially unable to earn a support by reason of Chorea, rheumatism, sci-
(Partially or Actually.) Here state the name and nature of every disease,ralgia, asthma, affection of lungs
and describe every wound and injury that causes the disability, no matter whether incurred in the service or not.

That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent.

That he has also been employed in the U. S. military or naval service otherwise than as stated aboveU. S. S. "Albatross"
(If in other service, here state in what organization, and when it began and ended.)That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the day of 18 That he has not received but applied for a pension 38 116 (May)
If now pensioned, state your rate, number of certificate, and disability

mentioned in it. If you have applied, but not received pension, state when and for what disability, and give number of claim.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints J. W. MORRIS, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorney to prosecute
