We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Claims that he was struck with a piece of shell on the left hip. Suffers with pains from left knee to hip and small of back. Interferes with the performance of manual labor.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 116; respiration, 20; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 3 inches; weight, 134 pounds; age, 46 years. General physical condition is good.

Scar on outer aspect of left hip, 2 1/2 inches below the greater trochanter. Scar is 3/4 inch long and superficial.

There is no apparent disability of the limb as result of wound. Has sensitiveness of muscles of left thigh, hip and lumbar region with pain on walking. Limbs perceptibly.

This is evidently due to muscular Rheumatism.

Heart and Lungs are normal.

No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 6/18 rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism for that caused by Wound Left Hip, and 0 for that caused by
