

PROOF OF AN OFFICER OR COMRADE.

STATE OF Maryland COUNTY OF Anne Arundel, ss:

ON THIS March day of March A. D. 1893, personally appeared before me, a Justice of Peace in and for the aforesaid County, duly authorized to administer oaths, Daniel Brice aged 47 years, whose Post-office address is Annapolis

State Vols., and that he is acquainted with George C. Miller [Name of Claimant.]

That the said George C. Miller while in the line of his duty, at or near Petersburg in the State of Virginia did, on or about the 30th day of July, 1864, become disabled in the following manner, viz: by being struck by a shell fired from the enemy and was seriously wounded in the left leg & that he was sent to Jackson Hospital at Alexandria Va for treatment & was there detained until the end of the war when he was discharged.
