

U. S. C. Cavalry, and that his address in 1912 was the same as that given by the claimant.

The public records as well as the records of Bayview Asylum should be searched for record evidence of the death of both former consorts and all testimony as to cohabitation and non-divorce should be verified with incidental inquiry as to whether the claimant has remarried or otherwise forfeited title to pension. In the absence of record evidence of death, the testimony of witnesses should be obtained who can testify from personal knowledge as to the dates of death of former spouses.
