

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE, 27, 1890.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having custody of its Seal, or a Notary Public, or a Justice of the Peace, whose Official Signature shall be verified by his own Official Seal, if he has one, or by the proper Clerk, under Seal.

aged 53 years, a resident of the Town of Junis Mills, county of

Talbot, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law,

declares that he is the identical John Blackwell who was enrolled on the

21 day of Sept, 1863, in Co. B, 7th Reg't of U.S. Colored Vols.,

day of October, 1866. That he is now unable to earn a support

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief per-

manent; that he has applied for pension under application No. 786,438; that he is a

pensioner under Certificate No. that he never drew a pension
If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under

the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. that he was never in the military or naval
service of the United States prior to the 21st day of
September 1863, nor subsequent to October 13 1866.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, GUY PLUMB & CO.,

of WASHINGTON, D. C., his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute his claim, and agrees to allow

them a fee of ten dollars if successful; that his post-office address is Junis Mills
