Dear Madam:

In order that it may be determined whether you have title to the increased rate of \$40 per month, provided by the Act of June 9, 1930, proof of your birth should be furnished as indicated in the accompanying circular letter.

If the evidence in paragraph 2 is unobtainable, the information in paragraph 3 should be furnished in order that a call may be made upon the Director, Census Bureau, in an effort to establish your correct age.

Your statement is on file showing your age as about forty-eight on December 19, 1908, and again on June 7, 1909, and at the date of your marriage to the soldier, January 13, 1887, your age is shown as twenty-six by a certified copy of the public record of your marriage.

Prompt action will be taken in your claim upon receipt of the evidence required.
