of June, 1865; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 38 years; height 5 feet 4 1/2 inches; complexion, black; hair, black; eyes, black; that while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Fort

Monroe, in the State of Virginia, on or about the 23rd day of April, 1864, he was injured in the ankle

which in line of duty and engaged in the service of the U.S. Army near Richmond, Va., ankle thrust & sprained

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: Army, Fort of Rock and

of treatment at Fort Monroe Va in the year of 1864 & 1865

That he has been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the County of St. Marys State of Maryland and his occupation has been that of a farmer

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when

disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he there-

fore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.
