

Act of June 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

State of Maryland, County of Charles, ss:

On this 21st day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

four, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace

within and for the County and State aforesaid,

Richard Butler, aged about 57 years, a resident of the State of Maryland

of Charlotte Hall County of St. Mary's

State of Maryland who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is

the identical Richard Butler, who was ENROLLED on the 24th

day of Oct, 1863, in Co. "G" 7th U. S. C. T. as a

Priv. (Here state rank, company, and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the service of the

United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at

on the 5th day of June, 1865.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated

above.

(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Heart Disease

in pensionable degree. incur of Suffering in both arms, Rheumatism

in both Shoulders, impaired eyesight, Piles, Kidney affection, Swelling in the right wrist

and hand (injuries from which disabled.) weakness in head which causes him to fall.

That said disabilities are not due to his

vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has

applied for pension under application No. 568338 That he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under

the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

of WM. W. DUDLEY,

his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS as prescribed by law. That
