SIR:

I have the honor to return herewith your request for a report of hospital treatment in Claim No. 6157790, with such information as is furnished by the records filed in this Office, viz: that Richard Butler Jr. Co. G. 7 U. S. C. I. was admitted to Hospital Field (flying) 25. A. C. (Camp Lincoln) City Point. Va. May 20. 1865, diagnosis not stated (prescription records on file do not cover date) and transferred May 21. 1865, and that he was admitted to G. H. Fort Monroe. Va. May 22. 1865 with chronic Diarrhoea, and discharged from service July 6. 1865. remarks. "Mastered out." Records of wounded pertaining to the Battle of Deep Bottom (near Richmond) Virginia Aug. 13-31. 1864, and such records of Hospitals at Point of Rocks. Va. as are on file bearing on the case, furnish no evidence in this case. No record found of Soldiers treatment for any disability, other than above indicated.
