more than fifty dollars, I have no bonds, stocks or investments and there is no

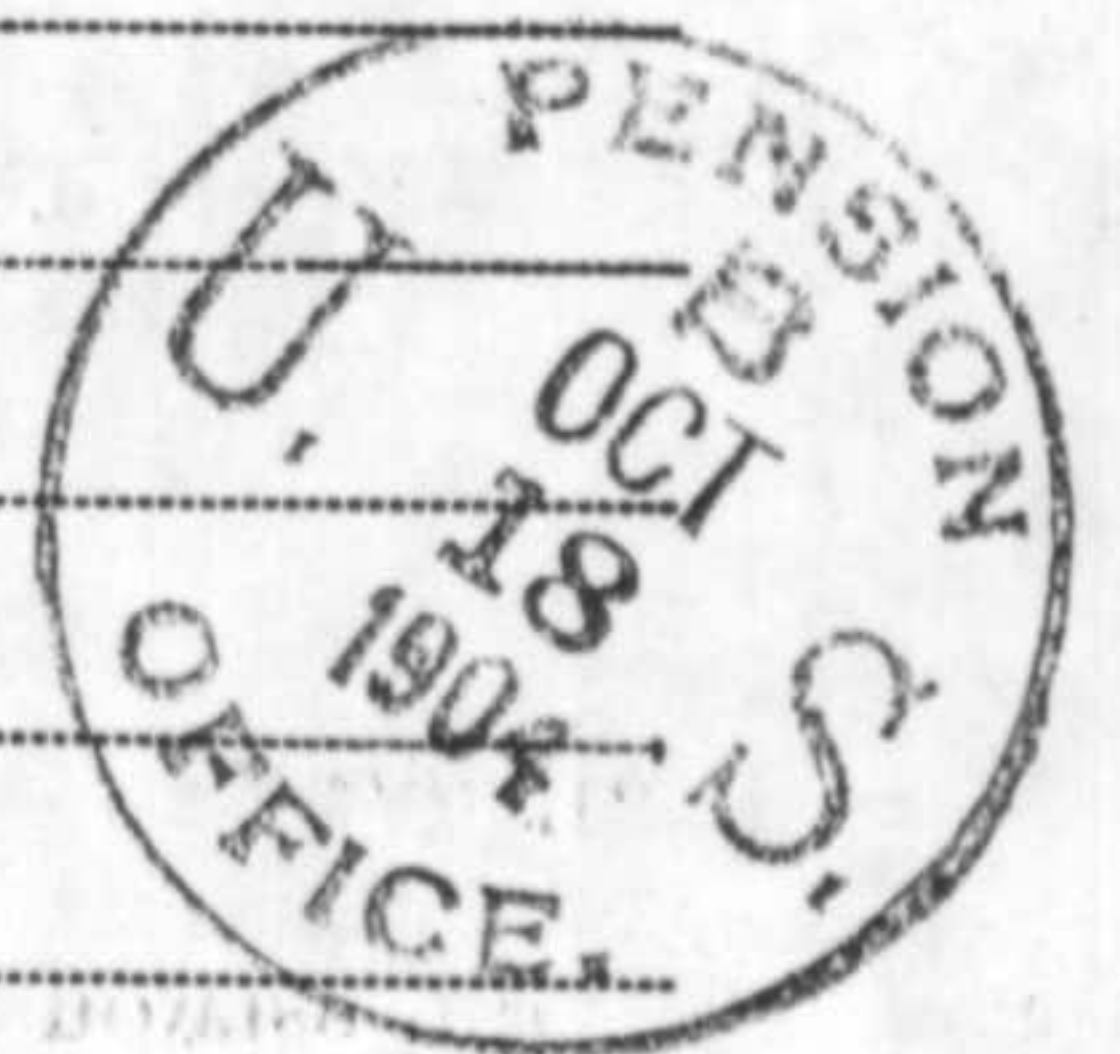
one legally bound for my support, and my said Husband Robert Dorsey had no life
