The muster roll of Co. "F" 2^d U. S. Colored Troops for July & Aug. 1865 reports Sergeant Benjamin Malone absent; "On det. Service: July 22.65", and Corp'l John R. Brown, present for duty; for Sept & Oct reports them both present for duty.

Regimental return for Sept. 1865 does not report them absent.

Company morning report for July 23.65 shows Sergt Benjamin Malone, absent on detached service. Sept 19.65 returned to duty. The records of this office do not show any additional absence of these men from Aug 1st to Nov. 1.65. The Regt. was stationed at Key West Fla., during Aug & Sept. 65. The name Benj. F. Malone is not borne on the rolls of that company.
