Sir:

The Claim for Bounty of Daniel Brice
Co. D, 30th Regt. U. S. C. I., is disallowed, and his
Certificate of Discharge herewith returned. The Records of this
Office show that he was paid, ^{in full and} \$300. Bounty installment; all he
is entitled to. Men who enlisted under the Act of July 4, 1864,
(although mustered out by reason of their services being no longer
required,) are only entitled to the installments of Bounty that had
become due at the time of discharge.

The Act of July 28, 1866, does not apply to men enlisting
under Act of July 4, 1864. Joint Resolution Jan. 13/67
