Volunteer Infantry is entitled to a pension at the rate of \$10.00 per month to commence on the 1st day of October 1880 one thousand eight hundred and eighty six and eight dollars per month from January 1, 1881. and to end March 13th date of death. This pension being for injury to right ankle.
